Level of Depression, Conflictive Thoughts among schools principals of Aden Governorate in Yemen as function of Demographic variables.

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Abstract

The purpose of the study is to investigate difference between depression and conflictive thoughts of School Principal in terms of demographical characteristics. For this investigation only gender and experience considered as demographical characteristics of School Principal. Here in this study investigator tries to find out how gender and experience effects on depression and conflictive thoughts. For the investigation sample was consist of 120 Schools Principals, in which 60 Principals was male, and another 60 Principals was female, both groups from adolescents those male and female were equally classify in more than 5 years experience and below 4 years experience from Aden city. The research tool for To assess the level Depression of students The Beck Depression Inventory – Second Edition (BDI-II) Inventory Designed and Constructed by Aaron T. Beck, Robert A. Steer, and Gregory K Brown, and to assess the conflictive thoughts the conflictive thoughts analysis inventory, constructed by C. G Deshpande were used, and ANOVA was applied to achieve the objectives. The result obtained through the study showed significant effect of demographical characteristics on depression and conflictive thoughts of School Principal were found.
