SOCIAL ATTITUDE OF HIGHER SECONDARY LEVEL TRIBAL

Abstract

The Present study is to find out the difference in level of social attitudeof highersecondary levelTribal Boys and Tribal Girls students. The sample consists of 240Tribal Boys and Tribal Girls students, out of which 120 are highersecondary level boys and 120are highersecondary level girls. For this purpose of investigation 'Social attitude scale' by Prof. Dr. A.S.Patel, Dr. Navin Patel & Dr. Dinesh Panchalwas used. The obtained data were analyzed through't' test to know the mean difference between highersecondary level boys & highersecondary level girls. The results show that there is a significant difference in attitude of women status of highersecondary level Tribal Boys and Tribal Girls students. There is a significant difference in attitude of sexual education of higher secondary level Tribal Boys and Tribal Girls students and there is no significant difference in attitude of sexual education of higher secondary level Tribal Boys and Tribal Girls students.
