A study of difficulties in implementation of reforms made in Teacher Training Programme

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Abstract

Efficient teachers are needed to implement innovative reforms being in education. For the purpose of recruiting competitive teachers, reforms have been made in teacher training programmes for the last five years. The present study was conducted considering its usefulness in context to opinions of B. Ed. trainees towards challenges for implementation of reforms. Its major objective was to study opinions of B.
