ABSTRACT

The aim of the study is to know the anxiety level of students with their arts and commerce faculty and living area east & west zone. The sample consisted of 230 students of ahmedabad city. Out of which 110 were east zone students and 120 were west zone students and 100 were arts faculty students & 130 were commerce faculty students. For this purpose of investigation "Anxiety Scale" by A.K.P. Sinha & L.N.K. Sinha was used. The obtained data was analyzed through the test to know the mean difference betweeneast zone students andwest zone students & also arts faculty students & commerce faculty students. The results show that there is no significant difference in anxiety level of east zone students andwestzone students. There is a significant difference in anxiety level of east zone students andwestzone students.

- (2) There is no significant mean difference between living area like east zone students & west zone students with relation to anxiety level.

METHOD:

The sample of the present study consisted of 230higher secondary students of Arts & Commerce faculty & east and west living area in Ahmadabad city of Gujarat.

(B) \underline{TOOL} :

In the present study tomeasure anxiety level."ANXIETY SCALE" by A.K.P. Sinha & L.N.K. Sinhawas used which is a very reliable tool in this inventory.

PROCEDURE:

The students who were studying in higher secondary schools of ahmedabad were randomly selected & sinha comprehensive anxiety scale was given & data was collected. The obtain data form 230 students were analysed with the help of mean. S.D. and 't' test.

STATISTICAL STRATEGY:

't' test was applied to know the significant differences between east zone students andwest zone students & also arts faculty students & commerce faculty students.

Table no. I show the anxiety level of arts faculty students & commerce faculty students. The results show that there is no significant difference in anxiety levelof arts faculty students & commerce faculty students.

Table no. II show the anxiety level of east zone students & west zone students. The results show that there is a significant difference in anxiety level of east zone students & west zone students.

CONCLUSION:

- (1) There was no significant difference between arts & commerce faculty students with relation to anxiety level.
- (2) There was a significant difference between east zone students & west zone students with relation to anxiety level.

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
